You can also book for lunch or dinner and enjoy a specially-designed menu featuring Kangaroo Island produce from some of the Island's best producers.

Sunday 6 August, from 12 noon to 4pm, you can meet wine producers from False Cape and Dudley Wines – for free tastings and lots of knowledge – find out more about Kangaroo Island's growing conditions and why the wines are now making their mark on the mainland.

On Sunday 13 August, at the second Meet the Makers, call in for a beer and cider tasting from Kangaroo Island Brewers, KI Ciders and the Drunken Drone. These beers and ciders are all produced on-island and during lunch and dinner, they will be paired with a fantastic array of delectable food offerings.

Sunday 20 August, La Boca Bar and Grill will host award-winning Kangaroo Island Spirits, showcasing their very well known range of gins and liqueurs, to be brilliantly paired with Kangaroo Island oysters. A tasting not-to-be-missed so call in and meet Geordan Ellis from KIS.

Finally, on Sunday 27 August, three wine producers will be on hand from 12 noon to 4pm, to present their wines – Islander Estate Vineyard, Bay of Shoals, and The Stoke Wines.

La Boca Bar and Grill at the Stamford Plaza Adelaide is open seven days a week for lunch and dinner, and for the entire month of August, Nic Arriola will showcase Kangaroo Island produce and beverages, so call in anytime during the month to enjoy what's on offer.
